★ A Pronoun is a word used in place of a noun.

Use of :- I = Asha :-

You - Asha :-

We - Grandma and Asha :-

I, you, and we are pronouns.

We use a pronoun in place of a noun.

I ! → I is used when You are talking about Yourself.

⇒ I am 6 year old.

We :- We is used when you are talking about yourself along with others.

⇒ We are studying.

You !- You is used when we are talking to someone in front of us.

⇒ You are a smart boy.

Use of → I am, You are, We are.

Ex. 1 → I am Ram.

I am a boy.

I am Sita.

I am a girl.

Use of ' - I am

Ex. 1 -

① I am a boy. (is/am)

② I am a boy. (I/He)

③ I am a girl. (are/am)

④ I am a girl. (I/We/You)

Use of:- You are

You are Ram.

You are a boy.

You are a girl.

Ex:-

(1) You are Ram. (am/are)

(2) You are a boy. (you/she)

(3) You are Sita. (am/are)

(4) You are a girl. (I/you)

Use of - We are

1. We are family.

2. We are players.

3. We are friends.

Ex. ① We are playing. (are/am)

② We are friends. (We/I)
